Tiffany V. Thiele Formally Endorsed as Democratic Candidate

HEBRON, Conn., May 16, 2018 – Delegates from Andover, Bolton, Hebron, and Marlborough unanimously voted to endorse Tiffany V. Thiele as the Democratic candidate for the 55th District in the Connecticut General Assembly.
